More Patients Discharged to Home

A vital part of recovery for patients is the ability to be discharged directly to the comfort of their own home or the familiar surroundings of their Community Based Residential Facility. 69% of rehabilitation patients met the team goals set by the day of discharge. **92% of our patients achieved their #1 goal of going home compared to 82% of rehab patients in the region and 84% of rehab patients in the nation.**
