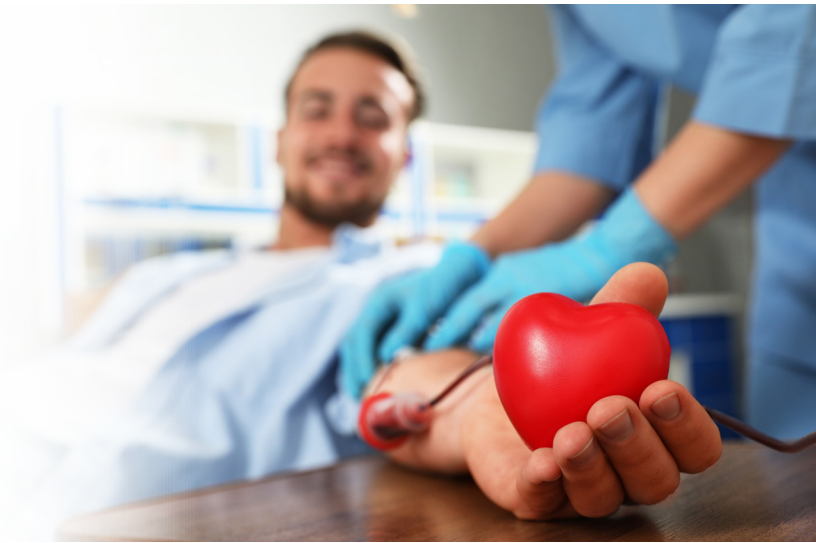


Join the NMDP Registry Drive
