

# COVID-19 Testing

## Diagnostic COVID-19 test

According to the CDC, testing is to be prioritized in the following ways:

### High Priority

- Hospitalized patients with symptoms
- Healthcare facility workers, workers in congregate living settings, and first responders with symptoms
- Residents in long-term care facilities or other congregate living settings, including prisons and shelters, with symptoms

### Priority

- Persons with symptoms of potential COVID-19 infection, including: fever, cough, shortness of breath, chills, muscle pain, new loss of taste or smell, vomiting or diarrhea, and/or sore throat.
- Persons without symptoms who are prioritized

### Tip

If you or your employee feel you may need testing, see your primary care provider or – for a no-cost assessment, call the COVID Call Center.
