Screening Location Tip Guide

Helpful guide for individual interactions, personal protective equipment precautions, and other considerations for your employees to use for guidance during COVID-19 outbreak.

Screening & Interaction

- Employee Entrance(s)
- And/Or Visitor/Vendor Entrance(s)
- And/Or Having any contact within 6 feet of another employee

Contingency Measures

- 1. Screen in well ventilated spaces.
- 2. Screeners practice extended use* of procedural or surgical facemasks; Use of facemasks for multiple subsequent days as they are fit for use.
- 3. Discard facemask when soiled, damaged, or hard to breathe through.
- 4. Screener only to wear gloves if open wounds are present to screeners hands or there is potential for physically touching the employee/visitor/vendor.
- 5. Have cloth masks available to Visitors/Vendors and hand them out as needed upon arrivals to your facility.

^{*} Extended use of facemasks refers to the practice of wearing specific PPE for repeated close-contact encounters with several individuals, WITHOUT removing it (doffing) between encounters.
