Intended Audience

This conference is designed for individuals who are involved in cancer treatment and education of cancer patients: physicians, pharmacists, nurses, radiation therapists, medical dosimetrists, nurse practitioners, clinical research associates, health educators, social workers, psychologists, cancer registry professionals and other interested health care professionals involved in cancer care.



Learning Objectives/Purpose

This conference is designed to educate and prepare health care professionals in issues relating to the treatment of cancer patients.

At the end of this activity, participants should be able to:

1. Discuss the testing used to diagnosis liver metastases, including labs and radiology.
2. Highlight the side effects associated with Lutathera and Pluvicto and the management including pharmacological and non-pharmacological strategies.
3. Explain how immune checkpoint inhibitors work to enhance the immune systems ability to recognize and attack cancer cells.
4. Review the challenges of interpreting clinical trial data and how to balance efficacy with potential harm or treatment burden.
5. Define adolescent and young adult population in oncology including why they are considered a unique demographic in cancer care.
6. Explain how proton therapy fits into a multidisciplinary treatment plan, often in conjunction with surgery, chemotherapy, and convention radiation therapy.
7. Outline the post-operative care required after breast reconstruction including wound care, pain management, exercise therapy, long term monitoring both physically and psychosocially.
8. Explore personal coping strategies and techniques that assist medical and radiation oncology professionals can use to manage emotional responses to death.
