More Patients Discharged to Home

A vital part of recovery for patients is the ability to be discharged directly to the comfort of their own home or the familiar surroundings of their Community Based Residential Facility. 80.6% of our patients achieved their #1 goal of going home compared to 79.7% of rehab patients in the region and 82.5% of rehab patients in the nation.
