More Patients Discharged to Home

A vital part of recovery for patients is the ability to be discharged directly to the comfort of their own home or the familiar surroundings of their Community Based Residential Facility. **87.1% of our patients achieved their #1 goal of going home compared to 85.2% of rehab patients in the region and 86.9% of rehab patients in the nation.**

Quality Care for Medical Problems

Aspirus Wausau Hospital Inpatient Rehabilitation continues to manage and treat our patients medical issues with the assistance of their medical doctors. Because of this teamwork, Aspirus Wausau Hospital Inpatient Rehabilitation has a 6.7% rate of unplanned transfers back to acute hospital care, compared to the 6-7% nationally.
