A firm commitment is made to involve our patients and family in their plan of care. Clear goals are established to challenge and motivate patients to assist them in improving their level of independence.

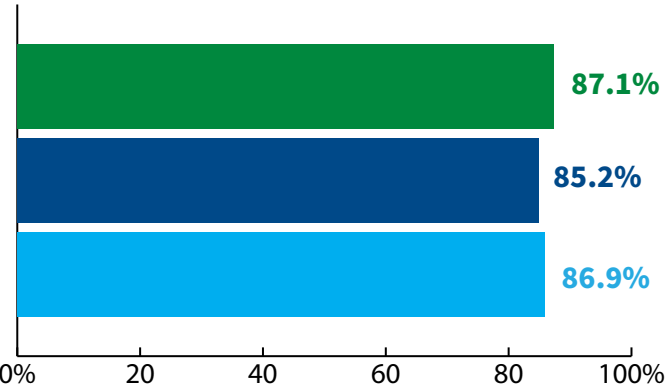
- **Average Age** = 64.1

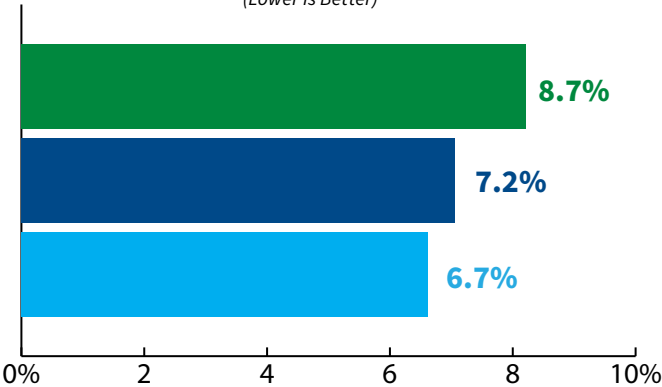

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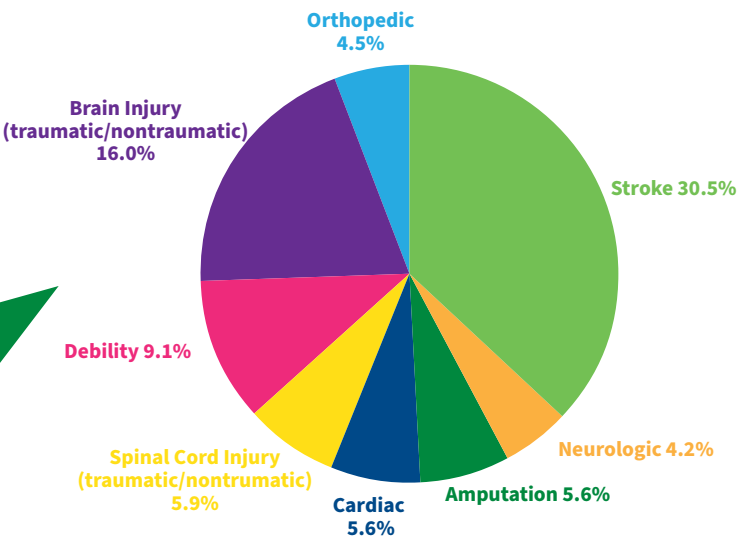

FY26 Aspirus Wausau Hospital Inpatient Rehabilitation Patients by Impairment Group

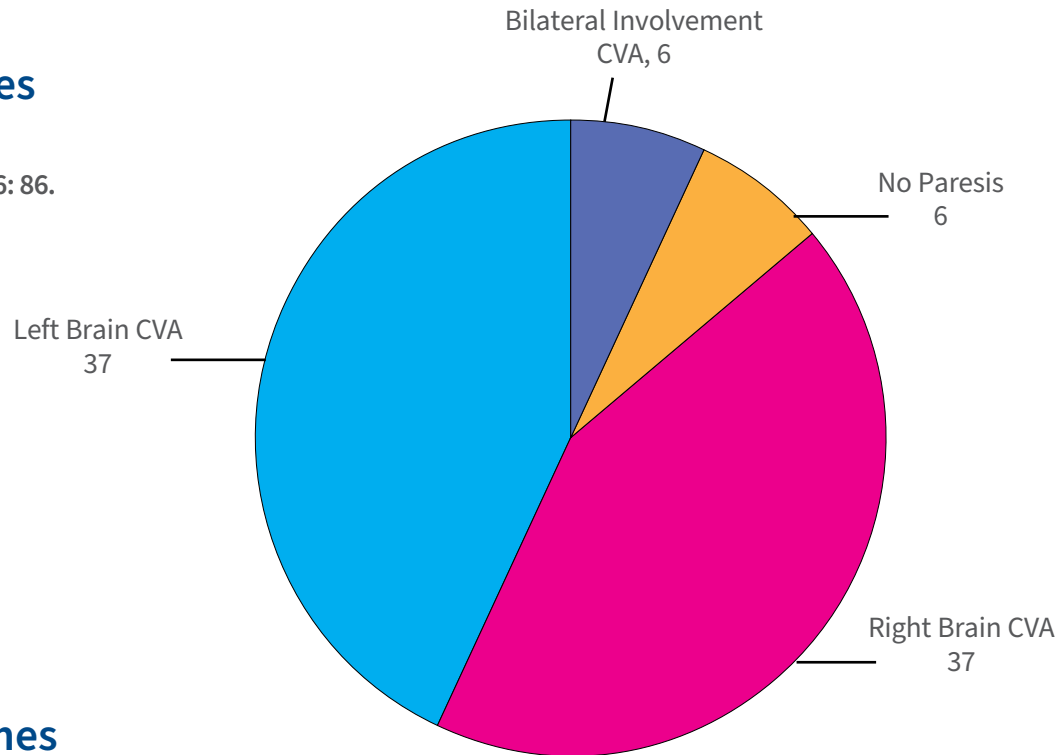
