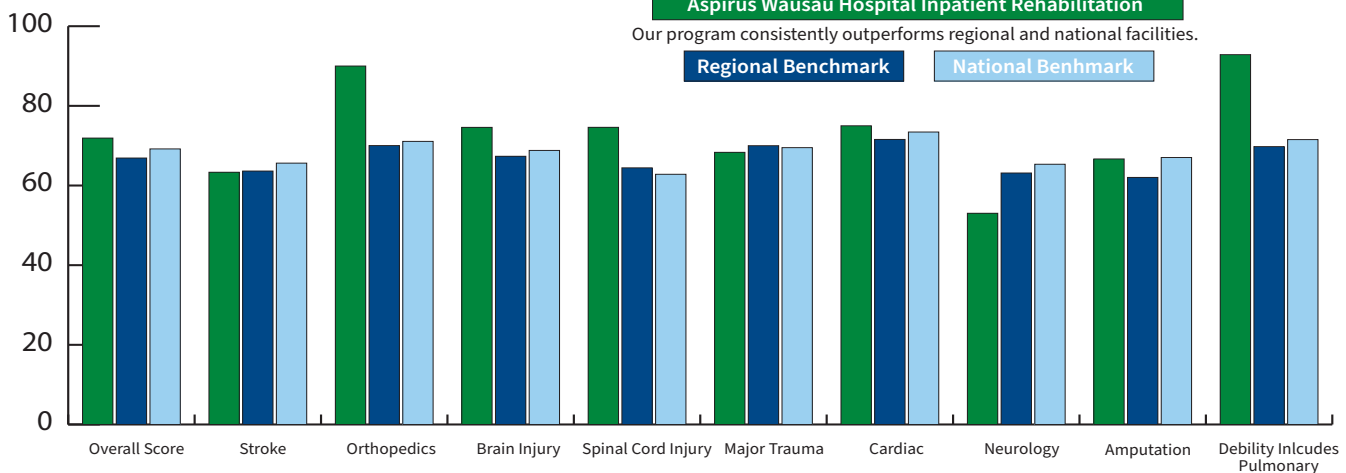
A firm commitment is made to involve our patients and family in their plan of care. Clear goals are established to challenge and motivate patients to assist them in improving their level of independence.

- **Average Age** = 60.8
- **Gender** = Male 68% Female 32%
- **Average Therapy Hours** = 3.5 hr M-F and 2.0 hr per weekend
- **Average length of stay for all diagnoses** = 13.7 days compared to region at 12.5 and nation 12.8.

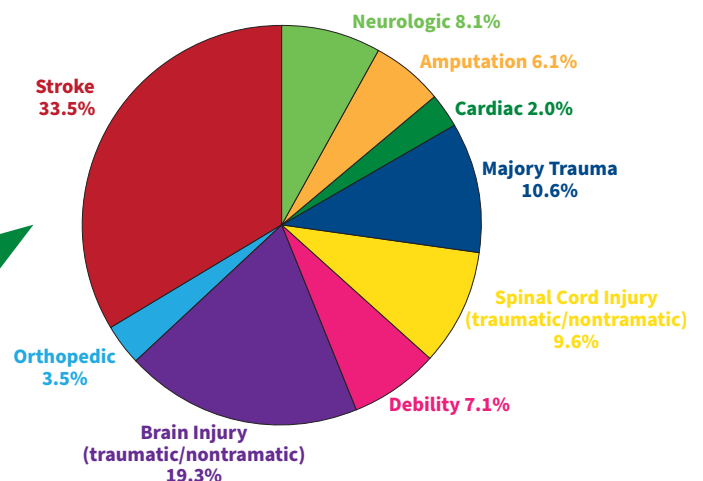

FY23 Aspirus Wausau Hospital Inpatient Rehabilitation Patients by Impairment Group

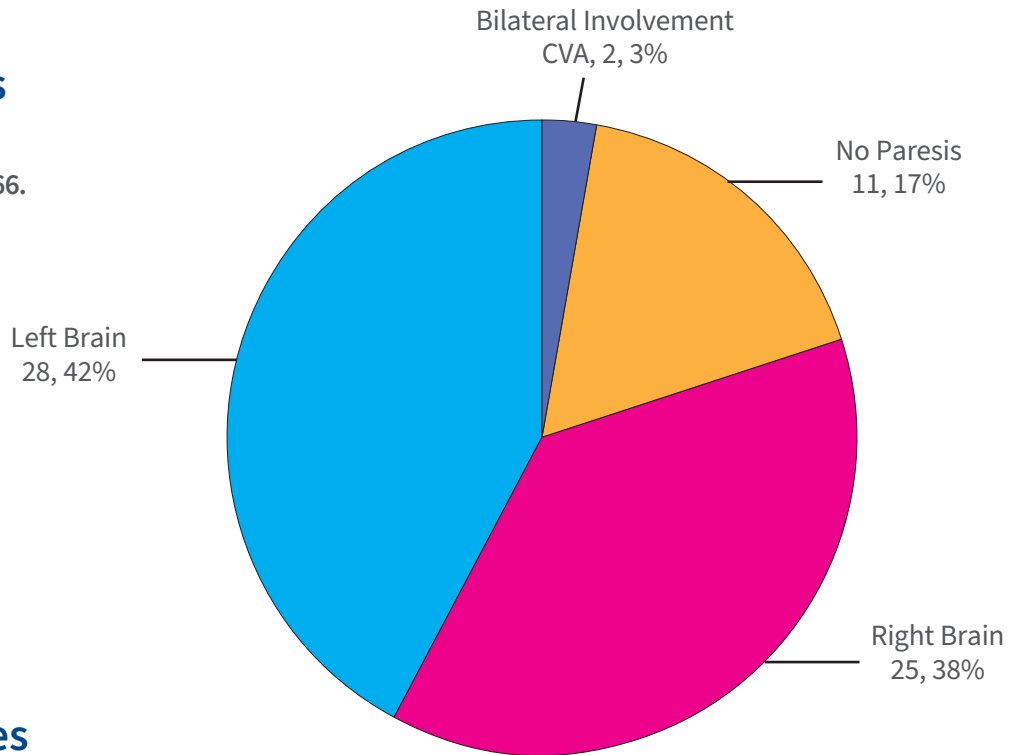
