




Serving Our Patients

A firm commitment is made to involve our patients and family in their plan of care. Clear goals are established to challenge and motivate patients to assist them in improving their level of independence.

- Average Age = 65.1
- Gender = Male 64.5% Female 35.8%
- Average Therapy Hours = 17.56 hours/7 days (Required is 15 hours/7 days)
- Average length of stay for all diagnoses = 12.3 days compared to region at 12.2 and nation 12.8.

Patient Improvement Scores

Our patients have a markedly higher improvement in functional status within a shorter length of stay than the benchmark scores for both the region and the nation. In the tables below, higher scores indicate better performance.




