

One-Hour Glucose Tolerance Test Instructions

- 1. No special diet needs to be followed. No need to fast before drinking Glucola. Do not eat or drink anything after you drink Glucola. You may resume a normal diet after your blood has been drawn.
- 2. You may chill Glucola in the refrigerator. You may pour it into a glass but do not add ice. Do not add or mix any other ingredients with Glucola
- 3. Start timing when you begin to drink Glucola (the first sip). Drink the entire contents within five (5) minutes.

**<u>Glucose load may cause nausea, vomiting, diarrhea, or fainting</u>. <u>Please contact your</u> <u>provider's office if you get sick after drinking the Glucola</u>.

- 4. Blood must be drawn 1 (one) hour after finishing Glucola. Please arrive at the lab 30 (thirty) minutes after drinking Glucola.
- 5. When you check in, please inform the receptionist what time your blood needs to be drawn.
