In a 2020 Uniform Data System for Medical Rehabilitation (UDSMR) report*, Inpatient Rehabilitation at Aspirus Wausau Hospital was a bench-mark leader in quality outcome scores for patient functional improvement and discharge to home. Aspirus Wausau Hospital Inpatient Rehab functional mobility status at the time of discharge are consistently higher than national outcomes. (70.8 vs. 67.)


