Dates/Camp Requirements

Rainbow's End is a Day Camp that will run the week of July 20-24 and July 27-31. Hours of camp are Monday – Thursday 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. and Friday 1:00 p.m. to 4:30 p.m (families are invited to come at 4:30 p.m. for awards ceremony and dinner). Enrollment will be limited to 25 children between the ages of 5-21 for each session. Due to the active nature of the program, limited facilities, and lack of medical equipment, we are not able to accommodate very medically involved children or those with serious physical limitations. Campers will be accepted at the discretion of the Camp Directors and Camp Nurse.

Facilities

Rainbow's End is held at the Samoset Boy Scout Council Camp located at 3511 Camp Phillips Road in Weston.

This beautiful facility is handicap accessible.

Program

Activities planned for the week include swimming, arts & crafts, nature, music and field trips.

Celebration Day “Friday”

Friday is Celebration Day at Rainbow's End. **There is no camp in the morning**, children should be dropped off at camp at 1:00 p.m. Parents are invited to join us at 4:30 p.m. for dinner and awards ceremony.
