Philosophy

We believe that it is every child's right to grow and live in a world which welcomes him or her exactly as it does everyone else...with identical privileges and responsibilities. Our goal is to provide safe activities that will be fun, will encourage creativity, and will enhance self-confidence.

Rainbow's End is a day camp for children and young adults with disabilities ages 5 - 21 that is held in Weston, WI for two weeks. Individuals 14 or older can volunteer to be camp counselors for one week or both weeks. Volunteers are paired one-on-one with a camper to create an individualized camp experience.

The duties of the counselor are:

- To provide friendship and companionship to the campers.
- To assist the camper as needed with games and activities such as swimming, eating, dressing, self-cares, and camper safety.
- To offer campers the opportunity to develop new friendships, interests, and self-esteem.
