



Hospice Volunteer Opportunities

Volunteer Area	Age Requirement	Description	Day/Time Needed
Bereavement Support (Hospice)	18+	From your home, make follow-up bereavement calls, write sympathy/anniversary cards to family members (calling cards available). Volunteers can also help with Bereavement Memorial Programs throughout the year.	As needed
Hospice House	18+	Volunteers help staff at the Hospice House by visiting patients, making meals, gardening, cleaning, stocking cabinets, etc. More duties assigned as needed.	Any day Time varies
Food Transport (Hospice)	18+ <i>(Valid driver's license required)</i>	Transport prepared meals and grocery items to Hospice House and pick up dishes from previous day. Pick up donuts and any 'shopping list' items at grocery store. Mon, Wed, & Fri stop and drop off frozen meals at Family House. Food Service vehicle provided.	Per your availability Monday - Friday 11:30am-1pm
Memorial Service (Hospice)	18+	Assist with annual event.	As scheduled
Patient/Family Support (Hospice Homecare)	18+	Volunteers needed to go into patient homes to provide support/respite for family members as needed. Provide companionship and visit with the patient while their loved one/caregiver leaves their side for a short amount of time.	As needed
Veteran to Veteran (Hospice)	18+	Volunteers who are veterans with military experience are paired with hospice patients who are also veterans to help foster a life review and allow healing by interacting and sharing experiences. Visit with a patient where they reside whether it be in a nursing home/facility or in the comfort of their own home. The camaraderie created between veterans has proven to be supportive for all involved.	As needed
Vigil (Hospice)	18+	Volunteers needed to sit with or be with hospice patient that is near death & doesn't want to be alone. Provide respite and support to family members during this end-of-life period.	As needed
