Your role will be to provide transport assistance within the hospital, ensuring patients and guests reach their destinations safely and comfortably. Additional Employee Health screening required. Help our guests by visiting with them in common areas, assisting staff with changing beds, cleaning, basic household duties, etc. to help keep the house looking fresh, organized, well-stocked and homelike. Medical/Surgical Intensive Care Unit (MSICU)	14+	Help out in a big way in a very busy hospital unit. Greet and assist visitors by helping them locate patient rooms, restroom or cafeteria. 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Neonatal Intensive Care Unit (NICU) Office	14+	Help NICU staff by greeting visitors and families in the NICU waiting room. Allow entry to the unit according to protocol. You will play a vital role by delivering flowers, mail, and other comfort items to patients and guests. Assist patients and guests in wayfinding. Assist as requested with other projects. Patient Visitor NEW	18+	Play a vital role in enhancing the emotional well-being of our patients by offering them companionship, conversation, and support. Assist with non-clinical requests like playing games/cards, helping with puzzles, reading to them, tidying their room, making phone calls, etc.	Per your availability Any day Flexible 8am-7pm
Pet Therapy HIGH NEED	21+ <i>(Dog must be certified by an American Kennel Club recognized organization.)</i>	Our patients, guests and staff need the comfort that sometimes only a dog can provide. Bring your certified pet to visit patients who would like additional social and emotional stimulation, visit our guests in waiting rooms, and visit with staff who love seeing furry friends. Sewing, Knitting, Crocheting HIGH NEED	14+	Do you want to volunteer but only from home? Do you knit, crochet, or sew? You can greatly help our patients by making items such as prayer shawls, pocket prayer shawls, stuffed animals, etc., as well as baby items all from the comfort of your own home. Patterns are available. Please help our patients by sharing your talents.	On your own time
Surgery Waiting Room (Day Surgery)	14+	Help convey the status of patients in surgery to waiting family members. Act as a liaison between doctors, staff, and those waiting. Keep track of family members and locate them when needed.	Weekly Thursdays – Noon-4pm
