Dr. Derrick and Sonya Siebert welcomed their son, Colin, into the world on May 18, 2017. Colin arrived a few weeks early and surprised the entire family. He spent two weeks in the Anya Marie Jackson Newborn Intensive Care Unit at Aspirus Wausau Hospital and received specialized care around the clock.

Thinking there were several weeks left before Colin was scheduled to arrive, Derrick happened to be out of town when Sonya went into labor. "As soon as it was apparent I was in labor, my husband caught the next flight back, which unfortunately didn't get him home until early the next morning," Sonya said. "With the helpful staff and nurses, I never felt alone. My husband's co-workers and families also stepped in to help by staying with me in the hospital and taking care of our other two daughters," she elaborated.

Derrick was able to talk to Sonya via cell phone through the whole delivery. As he flew home he was also able to keep an eye on their new son with the web cams the NICU has to allow parents to see their children remotely. We were more than thrilled with the care our son received."

It's been neat to watch the children grow and come out of their shells as they gain confidence about managing their Type 1 diabetes. Sometimes the older kids mentor the younger kids, but sometimes it's the other way around. It all depends on what age a child is diagnosed.

Gifts to Help Cancer Patients Are a Blessing

Having cancer is scary on its own, but having to drive several hours every day for multiple weeks to and from your radiation therapy appointments is an even scarier thought. Worse yet is the fear that comes from worrying that you'll be too sick to drive and will have to pay to stay in a hotel for weeks on end.

The fears described are common among patients who have cancer. Thanks to the family of Mary Ann Kallstrom, life is a little easier for many patients who have traveled to the Aspirus Regional Cancer Center in Wausau over the past few years.

What meant the most to us is that someone cared. We're grateful for the Mary Ann Kallstrom Cancer Support Fund.

A little over three years ago, the family of Mary Ann Kallstrom established a cancer support fund in her name through the Aspirus Health Foundation as a special way to honor Mary Ann's life and help others who are living with cancer.

The Kallstrom family was thankful for the caring team of physicians and nurses who became part of their lives and extended family during Mary Ann's illness before she passed away in September of 2015. So, they established the Mary Ann Kallstrom Cancer Support Fund to help support the needs of cancer patients and families with a special focus on transportation and housing needs.

A cancer patient housing pilot project was implemented to help provide a "temporary home away from home" to bring comfort and healing to patients with identified need as they receive cancer treatment.

According to Wendy Schultz, Supervisor of Oncology Social Services at the Aspirus Regional Cancer Center, "This housing has made the difference for some patients who otherwise may have foregone treatment due to the cost of travel and housing during extended cancer treatment."



The following feedback from patients who have stayed in the housing has been heartwarming:

"It meant a lot for our family- it can be very expensive for families dealing with cancer and all of the emotional and physical barriers/struggles. It's very nice to have a network of community people who care so much to make some parts of the journey easy."

"What meant the most to us is that someone cared enough to provide such a wonderful service to help me and other cancer patients."

"Truly, this made the difference between treatment versus no treatment for me as I could have not afforded to pay bills in two places. Thanks for developing this program and offering it."

The recent interior renovation project included a renovation of eight private patient bedrooms with private bathrooms and space for families and friends, along with the main kitchen, sub-kitchen, dining room, great room, meditation room, and guest bathroom.
